



FRIENDS OF MARINERS TRAIL 2011 CALENDAR PHOTO CONTEST

Contest Rules

The Friends of Mariners Trail announces its Sixth Annual Calendar Photo Contest. The public is invited to submit photos for the 2012 Mariners Trail Calendar.

Mariners Trail is a recreational trail along Lake Michigan from Manitowoc to Two Rivers, Wisconsin. Photos taken along the Lake Michigan lakeshore within the cities of Manitowoc and Two Rivers, including harbor areas, will be considered for prizes and for use in the 2012 calendar. Photos depicting activities along Mariners Trail are especially being sought.

The calendar will be put on sale in the Lakeshore area, and all proceeds will go to the maintenance, development, and promotion of Mariners Trail.

Photo Submissions:

- Each person may enter up to five photos. Entries must be high-resolution, digital photos in landscape (horizontal) format. (Photos of at least 1600 x 1200 pixels are strongly recommended.)
- Photos must not be substantially altered or enhanced.
- Each person submitting photos should use the entry form or otherwise submit the same information.
- Submissions are due by Monday, September 26, 2011. They can be emailed (with photo files as attachments) to marinerstrail@charter.net, or mailed or dropped off (with photo files on CD.) See addresses on entry form.
- Results will be announced on or about October 15, 2011. Winners will be notified by email or phone.

Judging and Prizes:

- A panel of at least three judges will choose 13 photos for use in the calendar.
- Cash prizes of \$100, \$50, and \$25 will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places, respectively. A \$50 prize will be awarded for the cover photo.
- Winners will also receive a free calendar.
- Besides appearing in the 2012 FOMT calendar, winning photos will also appear on the FOMT Website, and all submitted photos may be used in other Trail or Lakeshore Area publicity.

This contest is open to both amateur and professional photographers. Members of the Friends of Mariners Trail Photo Contest Committee may submit photos, but may not receive a monetary prize.
